Day 1: ARRIVE ANCHORAGE

Welcome to Alaska! Arrive into **Anchorage**, Alaska's largest city located between the Chugach Mountains and the Cook Inlet. Meet your Tour Director and transfer to your hotel.

Day 2: ANCHORAGE - RAIL JOURNEY - DENALI NATIONAL PARK

This morning transfer to the Anchorage Rail Depot where you will board a **Deluxe Dome Rail-car** for a full day scenic rail journey north to **Denali National Park**. Sit back, relax and enjoy breakfast on board this picturesque train ride as your train guide provide expert commentary. 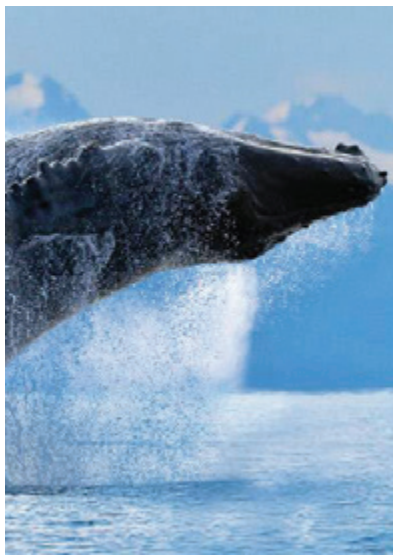

Day 6: ALASKA SEALIFE CENTER -AFTERNOON AT LEISURE

ASLC is located on the shores of Resurrection Bay in Seward and is Alaska's only permanent marine mammal rehabilitation facility.
